

MarMaRa's PhD awards : récompensons l'engagement de nos doctorants(es)

Description of the award

To reward PhD student's involvement in MarMaRa institute*initiatives, the institute offers PhD awards. This award will enable PhD students to attend a scientific event; undertake a short mobility in another national or European laboratory, or attend training sessions (courses, workshops...). This call is open throughout the year and PhD students can apply as soon as they wish. Applications will be evaluated by the scientific committee three times a year (October, March or April and June).

* All the activities in which PhD students are encouraged to participate are listed in the assessment grid.

Eligibility criteria:

- PhD student in 2nd or 3rd year working in a research team that belongs to MarMaRa institute.
- To be eligible the candidate must complete the assessment grid to justify a significant level of involvement in MarMaRa's activities.
- The three types of awards (event, short-term mobility, training) must be related to the institute's scientific fields.

Evaluation:

The application will be evaluated by the scientific committee which meets three or four times a year. Thus, a delay of up to two or three months can be expected between the submission of the application and its evaluation.

Documents required:

- Assessment grid
- CV of the candidate
- Cover letter (1 page max, see section in the application form)
- Program of the event or program of the training or description of the research conducted in the foreign laboratory.



Terms of engagement:

All awardees will be expected to provide a short summary of their event/short mobility/training.

All scientific publications and communications which have benefited of the financial support of MarMaRa must mention the following sentence: "*This work received support from the French government under the France 2030 investment plan, as part of the Initiative d'Excellence d'Aix-Marseille Université - A*MIDEX (AMX-19-IET-007) through the Marseille Maladies Rares Institute (MarMaRa).*"

Publications must be deposited in the A*Midex HAL AMU collection, the University's open archive.

Deadline:

This call is open throughout the year.
